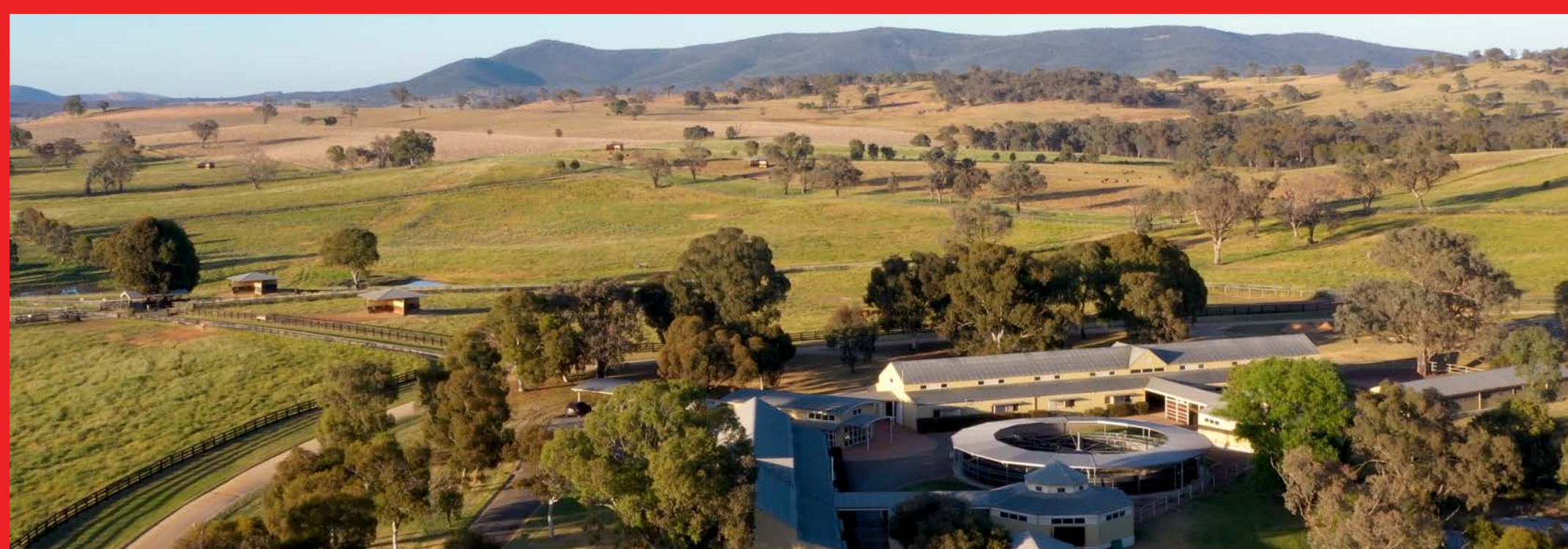

In 1993, Twin Hills became an integral part of Jack and Bob Ingham's Woodlands Stud. It was sold in 2008 to Sheikh Mohammed's Darley and was soon central to Godolphin's racing operations.

Olly and Amber Tait purchased Twin Hills Stud in April 2017. Since then, the farm's roll call of successful horses has included Cherry Tortoni, Kimochi, Azula, Vagrant and Felix Majestic – all raised in this ideal environment.

Twin Hills Stud's deep history remains an inspiration for an exciting future.
