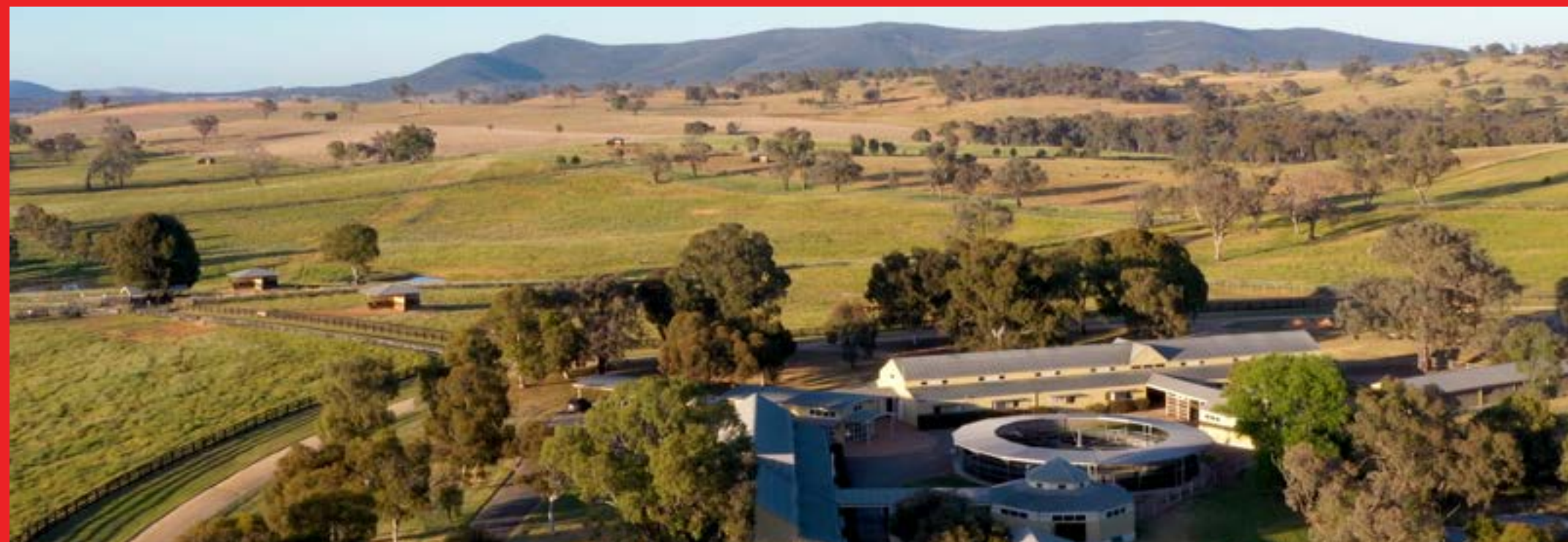

Raised and grazed on superior land

Rolling pastures and plentiful water, the finest facilities accrued over several decades of lavish investment, and dedicated, expert staff with judgement and experience. Twin Hills Stud – it's a great place to be a horse.

Established by American expat Fred Calvin in the Sixties, Twin Hills Stud was bought by media personality Mike Willesee in the early 1980s. Renamed Trans Media Park Stud, Willesee built world-class facilities and stood leading sires Snippets and Rubiton.

In 1993, Twin Hills became an integral part of Jack and Bob Ingham's Woodlands Stud. It was sold in 2008 to Sheikh Mohammed's Darley and was soon central to Godolphin's racing operation.

Olly and Amber Tait purchased Twin Hills Stud in April 2017. Since then, the farm's roll call of successful horses has included Kimochi, Lofty Arch, Pallaton, Wings Of Song, Vagrant, Pure Aqua and Straight Charge – all raised in this ideal environment.

Twin Hills Stud's deep history remains an inspiration for an exciting future.
